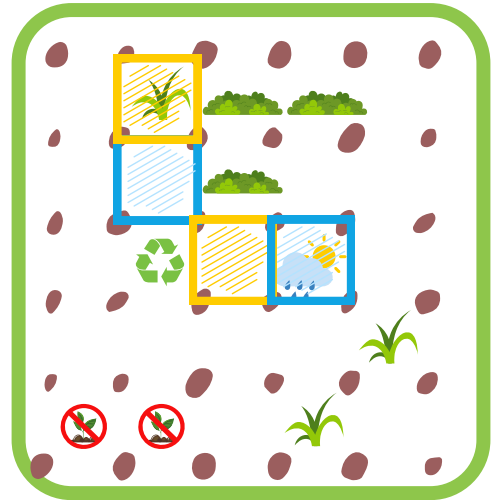




# Shepherd Dots

## 1 Shepherd Dots in a nutshell:

The goal of Shepherd dots is to earn shepherd points to achieve the title of Master Shepherd. Players connect dots with lines to form enclosures, earning points based on the number of enclosures created and Shepherd activities 'completed'. The winner of the game is the player that receives the Master Shepherd award or the highest award.

- ✓ It allows children to build essential mathematics skills such as addition, problem-solving, and spatial awareness.
